


FOOTBALL EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

Venue Directions: From Jasper, follow Hwy 78 to Sumiton. From Birmingham, follow Hwy 78 to Sumiton.



Emergency Personnel:

 - b. Notify individuals designated on the emergency contact list
4. Direction of EMS to Scene
 - a. Open appropriate gates
 - b. Designate individual to "flag down" EMS and direct to scene
 - c. Scene control: Limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area


