





Venue Directions: From Jasper, stay straight on Hwy 69 South for approx. 12 miles. Oakman High School is on the Right. To get to the field, Turn Right into entrance between Gym and High School. Gate at Right corner of Field. Turn Right onto School St. Take 1st Right to field house. Open gates at each corner of Field.
